2010 Bev Gladder Mentorship Award

Purpose:

Annual recognition of a COSA member who has distinguished him/herself within the profession as a mentor to aspiring or new school administrators.

Selection Criteria:

The award recipient must:

1. Be an active COSA member
2. Have demonstrated a commitment to mentoring over time by providing support to more than one new or aspiring administrator
3. Be known to teach, advise, sponsor, support and otherwise aid new or aspiring school administrators
4. Model exemplary leadership, ethics and professionalism consistent with the highest standards of Oregon's public school administrators
5. Volunteer time beyond scope of paid or assigned professional duties to offer mentoring support for new or aspiring school administrators
6. Be nominated by a peer or beneficiary of the mentoring support recognized by this award

Nominating Process:

Individuals seeking to present a nominee for the 2010 Bev Gladder Mentorship Award should submit a letter of not more than two typewritten pages listing the name and position of the nominee and a statement noting how the nominee meets the selection criteria for the award.
