
The 2015-2016 school year marks the third year of statewide implementation of Oregon's Kindergarten Assessment. This session includes:



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2015-2016 Statewide Kindergarten **Assessment Improvements**

- ☐ Verbal <u>or</u> pointed responses allowed in Early Math
- ☐ Revised instructions and directions to the student
- ☐ A single Secure Student Booklet (with a section in Spanish/English and a separate section in English Only)





2015-2016 Statewide Kindergarten Assessment Improvements (Cont.)

- Secure Assessor Score Sheet for the TA
- Assessor Booklet (A2) is now non-secure
- Student Roster reports available within Consolidated Collections immediately after data entry
- Field Test of alternate versions of English Letter Names and English Letter Sounds measures

2015-2016 Statewide Kindergarten Assessment Window

- The statewide assessment window is from August 10 through October 22. Within that window, districts are to establish their own six-week window beginning on the first day of school.
- Data are due to ODE by October 30. This year districts will have immediate access to their data.
- November 19- December 4, 2015 districts will have the opportunity to review the data that they have submitted and make changes or updates.

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








Early Learning And Kindergarten Standards Alignment Project

- Aligned standards will supply clear, comprehensive, and united objectives for early childhood professionals and kindergarten teachers to support the continuity of practice across settings







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
