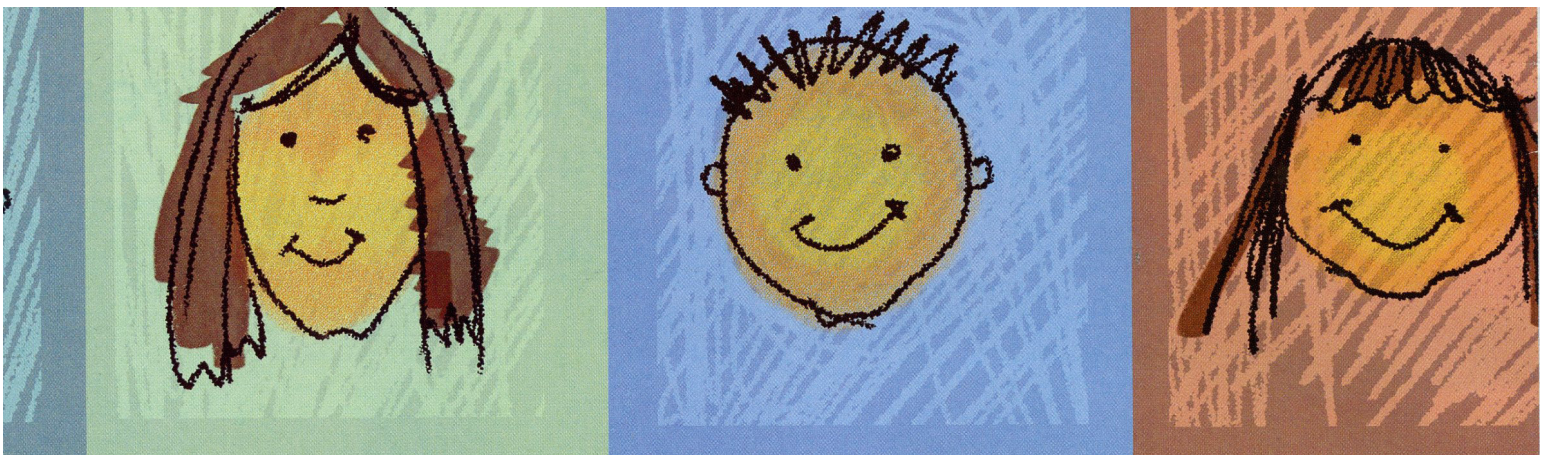

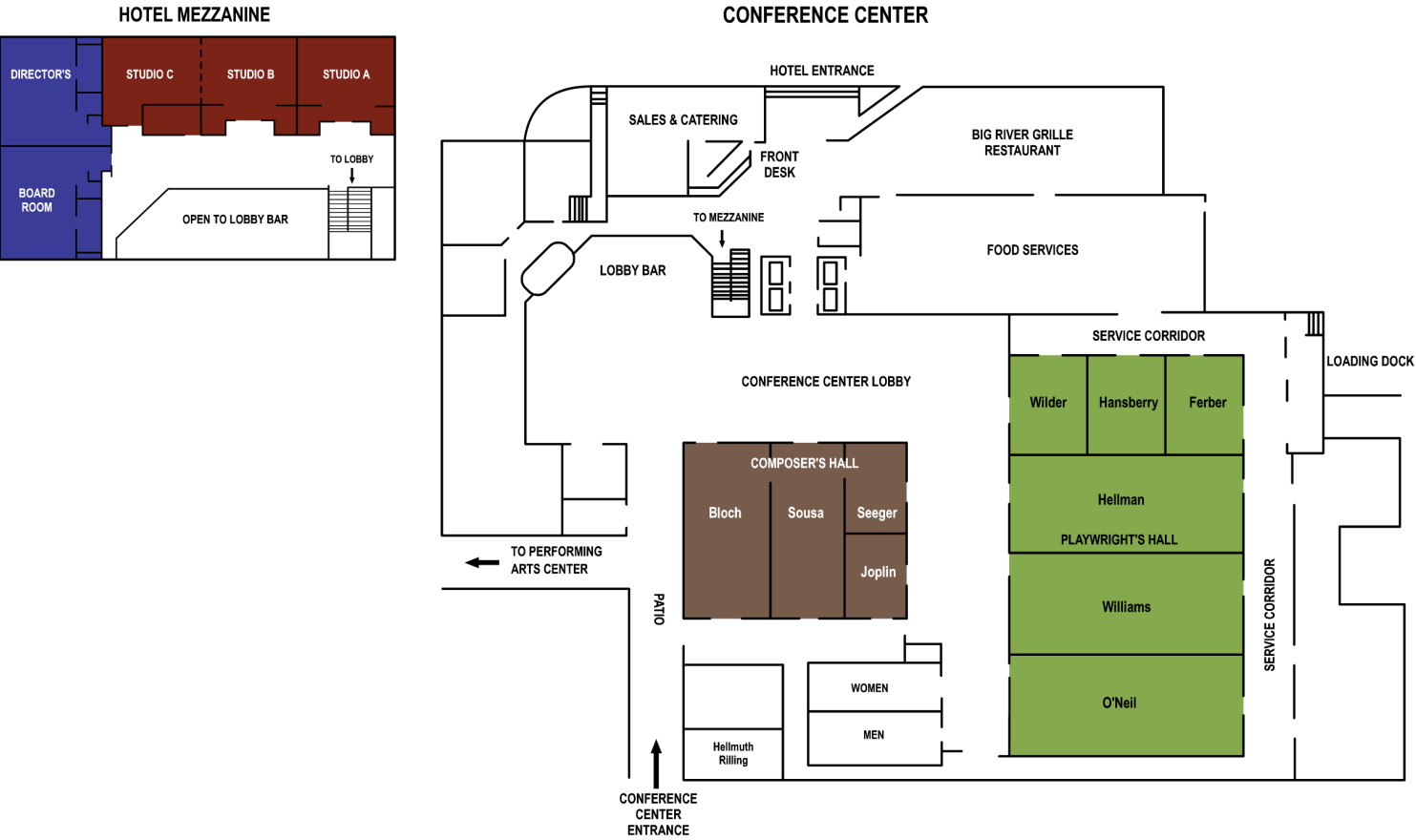

HOW TO INSTALL THE EVENT APP

Via Invitation:

- On the device you will be using the app, open the email you received from CrowdCompass (search all mailboxes for CrowdCompass)
- From the email, click on “Download the app”. This will download the “COSA Events” App

Via the App Store or Google Play Store:
