<b>OASSA Asst. Principal of the Year</b>	August	October 10, 2018	December	Nominee must be an active assistant (or vice) principal and a current member of OASSA & NASSP.
<b>OACOA Achievement of Excellence</b>	October	December 5, 2018	January	Nominee must be a current OACOA member and must have completed 5 years in a supervisory position.
<b>OASSA Principal of the Year (M.S. &amp; H.S.)</b>	January	March 13, 2019	May	Nominee must be an active middle or high school principal and a current member of OASSA & NASSP.
<b>OESPA National Distinguished Principal (Elem.)</b>	January	March 13, 2019	May	Nominee must be an active Elem. Principal and a current member of OESPA & NAESP.
<b>Bev Gladder Mentorship Award</b>	February	May 1, 2019	June	This award recognizes a COSA member who has distinguished him/herself within the profession as a mentor to aspiring or new school administrators.
