

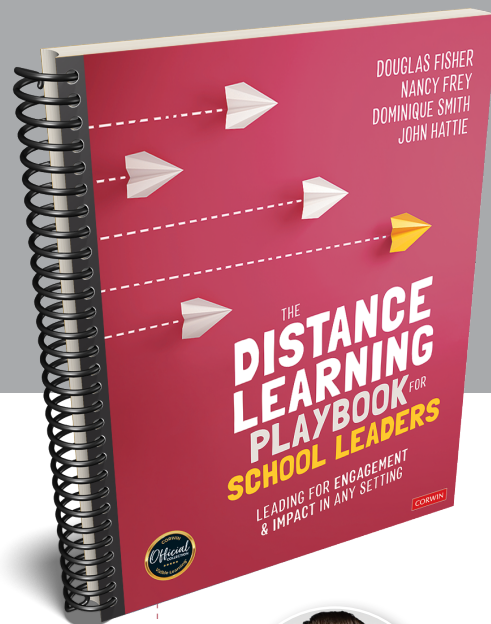


# Supporting Educators with next steps in Distance Learning
