



COSA – Chalkboard Project Aspiring Leaders Project Preliminary Administrator License

Greetings from COSA,

Thank you for your interest in applying for Leading for Learning, the innovative, equity-based licensure program offered by COSA Leads in conjunction with the Chalkboard Project. The 18-month program, which begins in January of 2018, integrates a one-year, half-time internship with five online classes taught by Oregon administrators, as well as a series of educational equity workshops.

Applications are due by Nov. 15, and candidate selection will be announced Dec. 15. Classes begin Jan. 8. Information about program cost and class schedules is attached to this email. Candidates will be selected jointly with Chalkboard Project based upon their potential for instructional leadership, team-building and interpersonal skills; as well as references, personal statements, and strength of application.

Program requirements:

- Oregon teaching license
- At least five years of teaching experience, including two years in teacher leadership roles
- A master's degree with a 3.0 G.P.A. or higher

Step 1: Complete the online application at <https://www.CUChicago.edu/ApplyNow>

- Go to "Partnership Programs," select "COSA Educators" and Spring 2018 term.
- Use the attached form to submit official academic transcripts from all institutions where you have earned a degree. Mailing instructions to CUC are included on the form.
- In the "Objective Statement" section of the application, please address your commitment to educational equity.
- If you want an MA with the PreAL, then select the MA and we will add the PreAL automatically; the term is also Spring.
