

support all-day kindergarten, which therefore will be implemented at the expense of students in grades 1-12. The District would need to reduce costs by the equivalent of 24 teaching positions. We are still down 62

FTE from 2008. This would further increase class sizes and reduce programs.

- Forest Grove students to receive about one year less of instructional time than the national average
- Loss of one course opportunity every year grades 7-12
- · Lack of flexibility for extended time for all students to be on track for graduation
