Course content includes the presentation of the latest evidence on mental health and substance use challenges and disorders among youth in the United States and it incorporates the latest evidence on treatments and services available to youth as relevant resources. Whether you are a teacher, school administrator, parent, mentor or friend, this 8-hour certification course has information everyone can use.
