THE DISTRICT

In 2013 the Chehalis School District (CSD) launched its Student Achievement Initiative (SAI), aimed at preparing every graduate to be ready to pursue college, certificate, or trade programs that lead to living-wage jobs. The SAI team includes leaders from the Chehalis community and from Centralia College. The SAI touches every grade level, focusing on improving instructional practices, creating a culture of postsecondary expectation, and preparedness.

Chehalis enjoys strong community support for its schools. The community consistently supports district levies. The district also recently completed a highly successful bond campaign realizing new and highly functional elementary schools sharing a learning campus with each other and the middle school. In addition, the Chehalis Foundation provides substantial support for the district's improvement initiatives.

Administrative tenure in the Chehalis School District is high. Ed Rothlin is retiring after serving ten years as superintendent. The superintendent prior to Rothlin served for fifteen years. The district is served by a strong and long-tenured school board. In 2018 the Board was recognized as the Washington school board of the year.

The mission of the Chehalis School District, in partnership with the community, is to meet the individual learning needs of students by providing a comprehensive educational program that inspires and prepares them to become responsible, contributing citizens.

THE COMMUNITY

Chehalis, Washington lies in a valley alongside Interstate 5 mid-way between Seattle and Portland, and mid-way between the Cascade Mountains and the Pacific Coast.
