- Works well with others; strong collaborator that empowers students, staff, parents, school board, and community members.

The District



The **Myrtle Point School District** serves approximately 529 students in one junior high/high school and one Pre-K-6 school. The District employs a staff of 31 licensed employees, 43 classified employees, 6 confidential employees, and 3 administrators. The District has a general fund budget of about \$8.7 million and passed a capital improvement bond of \$2.7M in 2012.

Highlights about the District include:

- Strong career-technical education (CTE) programs including the only Future Farmers of America (FFA) program in the county.
- College credit courses offered at the high school.
- 1:1 technology equipment in both schools.
- Preschool program offered.
- Continually growing LifeSkills program.

Myrtle Point Junior/Senior High School

- The hub of the community with students in grades 7-12.
- Long-established programs, including FFA, Drama, Band, Student Leadership, Woodshop and Athletics, augment the outstanding learning opportunities for students.
- Advanced course offerings this year include college-level Math, English, and CTE courses.
- MPHS has a relatively new student lounge, upgraded science classrooms and new restrooms that were added during the 2012 bond renovations.
- The mighty Bobcats wear the colors royal blue and scarlet red. The Bobcats are supported by the community-based Bobcat Booster Club which helps to provide funding support for athletics and other student groups.

Myrtle Crest Elementary School

- An active elementary school with 324 students in preschool through sixth grade. The primary wing houses a half-day preschool and an all-day kindergarten through grade 2, while the main building houses grades 3-6.
- The 2012 bond measure provided new flooring and carpet throughout the main building and new student cubbies in the primary wing.
- The facility includes a full-size gym, a mini-gym and a combination cafeteria/gym.
- The campus has three playgrounds, a track, a baseball field and a greenhouse to promote wellness learning.
- Reading and math curricula are taught through a successful school-wide Title program.
- Student's learning experience is enriched by music classes with both band and vocal teachers and Physical Education to K-6.
- Supported by an active Parent-Teacher-Kid (PTK) program which sponsors field trips and assemblies.
