Steps of PLC Data Protocol

1. Data Analysis (2-3 min)
2. **Strengths and Weaknesses** (8 min)
3. Instructional Strategies (18 min)
4. Smart Goal (2 min)
5. Results Indicator (2-3 min)

Strengths and Weaknesses

- Strengths: What questions did students do well?
- Weaknesses: What questions did students struggle with?

Strengths

- Why discuss strengths?
 - Determine why students did well
 - Identify the connection between success and instructional strategies

Weaknesses

- Identify consistent areas of struggle
- Analyze instructional strategies attached to weaknesses
- Determine a different strategy that may be more effective
- Implement identified strategy as a team

PLC Work

- Begin analyzing student work to identify student strengths and weaknesses
- Begin to identify instructional strategies that may relate to student strengths
- Be vulnerable and willing to discuss why another teacher has had more success in a content area than you have
