3 Keys of Effective Communication During Transitions

Early

o Proactive communication as a mindset, not just an ideal

Often

Create the echo—same information, multiple sources

Accurate

- Give the right info—always
- Direct to the right info—especially when you don't have it
- Correct misinformation right away
