# Irvington School Discipline Plan

## Stage 1 Behavior Report

#### Student stays in the classroom

- Behavior can often be reversed through early stage interventions
- Rule violations should have pre-planned corrective consequences

## Stage 1 Behavior Report

#### **Teacher Responsibilities:**

If a corrective consequence is necessary

- Implements appropriate intervention
- Completes a Stage 1 Behavior Report
- Contacts parent(s)/guardian

Three Stage 1 Behavior Reports can constitute a Stage 2 Behavior Report.

## Stage 2 Behavior Report

#### Student stays in the classroom

- Rule violations should have pre-planned corrective consequences
- Teacher stays calm and continues teaching after responding to the misbehavior

## Stage 2 Behavior Report

#### **Teacher Responsibilities:**

- Implements appropriate intervention
- Completes a Stage 2 Behavior Report
- Submits a Stage 2 Behavior Report to Administrator
- Makes a parent phone call

## Stage 2 Behavior Report

#### **Administrative Responsibilities:**

- Consults reporter/teacher about Stage 2 Behavior Report
- Resolves incident within 2 days
- Contacts parent/guardian
- Returns Stage 2 Behavior Report to teacher

## Stage 3 Behavior Report

## Student needs to be removed from the classroom

- The student is presenting a safety issue
- The student is disrupting instruction despite multiple intervention attempts

## Stage 3 Behavior Report

#### **Teacher Responsibilities:**

- Implements appropriate interventions
- Completes a Stage 3 Behavior Report
- Teacher calls office and asks for administrative assistance

## Stage 3 Behavior Report

#### **Administrative Responsibilities:**

- Picks up student and Stage 3 Behavior Report, student does not return to class until having a conference with Admin.
- Consults reporter/teacher about Stage 3
   Behavior Report within 24 hours
- Returns Stage 3 Behavior Report to teacher
- Contacts parent(s)/guardian
- Reviews possible student support through RTI continuum
