

• An Innovative, Learner Centered Approach To Teaching and Learning. In a Performance Based System (PBS) Learners Work At Their Performance Level And Advance Through The Curriculum When They Have Demonstrated Proficiency Of The Required Knowledge Or Skills.

- Guaranteed And Viable Curriculum
- Comprehensive Assessment System
- 0-4 Scoring Scale
- Electronic Assessments, Scoring, And Tracking System
- System To Group And Re-group Learners
- Accountability/Monitoring System


