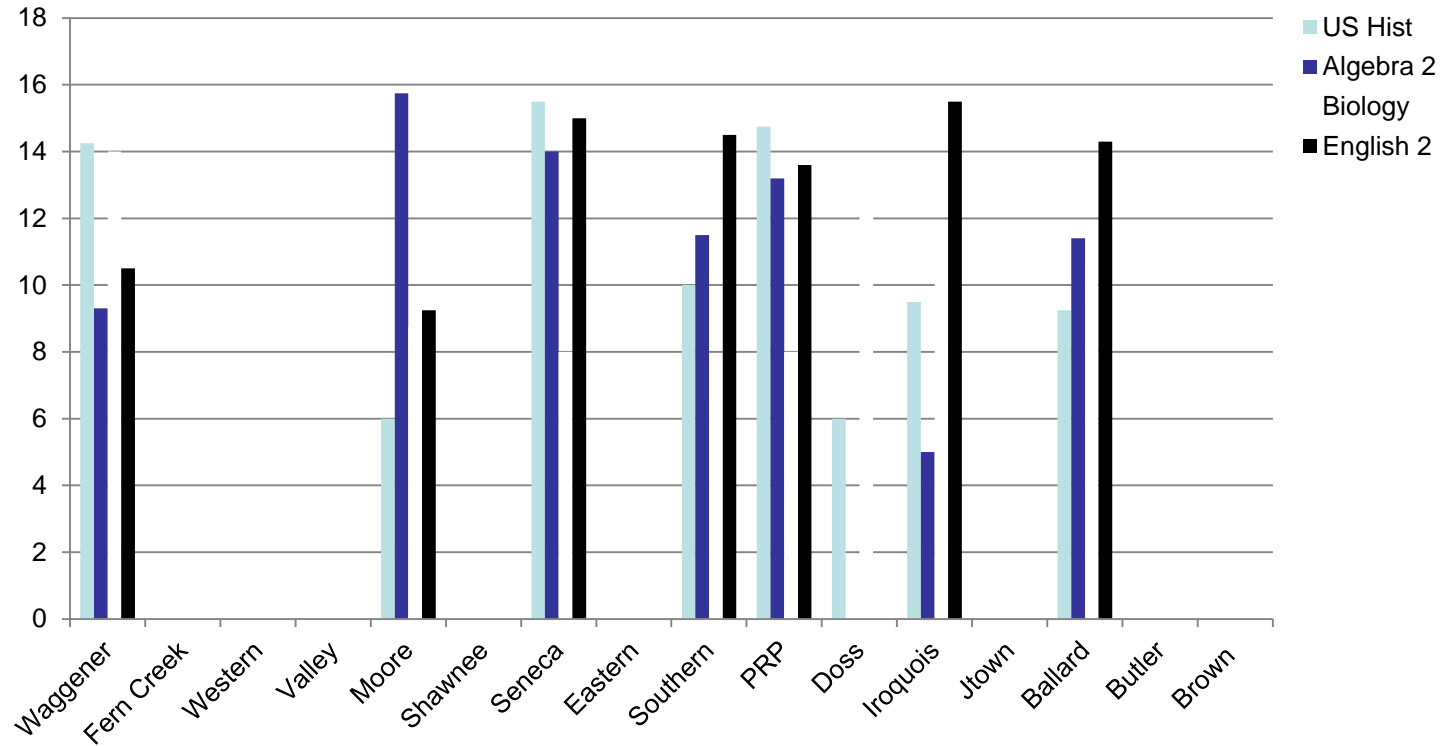

Understanding the Scoring Guide

- Using *Big Idea 1: Building a Collaborative Culture*
 - What are the critical behaviors and practices described for an *Effective PLC*?
 - What are the differences between Effective practices and those described as *Needs Improvement*?
- Consider the same questions for *Big Idea 3: Establishing a Focus on Results*

Applying the Scoring Guide

- During the video, use the scoring guide to evaluate the practices you observe.
- Assume the following, when using the scoring guide:
 - You may not see everything described, so may not be able to completely evaluate every bullet using the video clip.
 - Base your judgment on a preponderance of evidence, not on meeting every statement for particular bullets.
 - You may decide to highlight some things you see under one performance level and some in another in the text itself.
 - In the notes section, try to describe evidence you see that leads to your judgments.

- How did you apply the scoring guide to make decisions?
- How well did the scoring guide seem to work in guiding your observation
- What was challenging about using the scoring guide?

- What are the potential uses of the scoring guide with PLCs in various states of experience and effectiveness?
