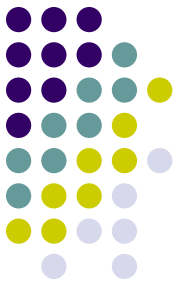
LF-OR

Standards at a glance



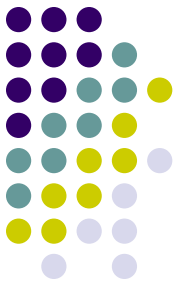
Give one get one

Share your standard with someone, learn about another standard from that same person

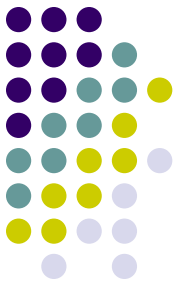

- Discuss how adding the missing standard will work towards solutions to challenges you face

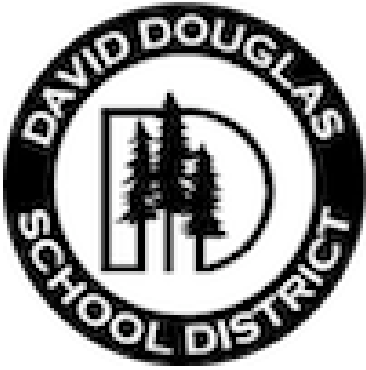

 - Wealth of resources: videos, downloads, books

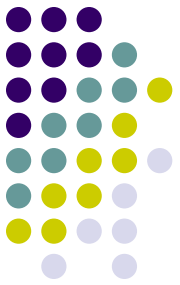
Collaboration

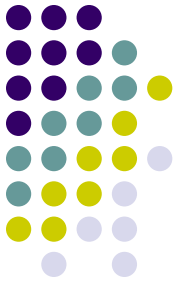

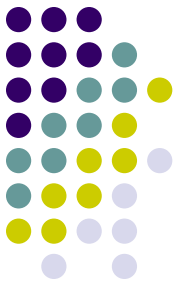


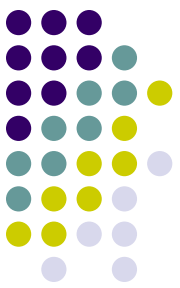
