- Education Leadership Coalition Appointments

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OASE Executive Committee objective:

- Provide more time and support for the Oregon recipient as she/he completes the challenging national application process.

**2019 Superintendent of the Year**

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**May 1, 2018 – Nominations Open**

- Nomination forms will be sent to all COSA members and made available on the COSA website beginning in May.
- OASE Executive Committee encourages regions to consider nominating a colleague.

**August 10, 2018 – Nominations Close**

- Please complete nomination form and send to COSA staff member Joanne Fey ([joanne@cosa.k12.or.us](mailto:joanne@cosa.k12.or.us)) no later than Friday, August 10.

**2019 Superintendent of the Year**

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**August 11-30, 2018 – Applications Reviewed, Winner Selected**

- OASE Executive Committee members will review nominations and select the 2019 Oregon Superintendent of the Year.

**August 31, 2018 – Winner Notified**

- The 2019 winner will be notified no later than August 31.

**September 1-October 31, 2018 – Winner Receives Support for National Application**

- A panel of former Oregon Superintendent of the Year Award recipients will be available to support the 2019 winner as she/he completes the national application.

**2019 Superintendent of the Year**

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**November 1, 2018 – National Application Due**

- The deadline for submitting the 2019 Oregon Superintendent of the Year’s national application to AASA is October 31.

**November 10, 2018 – Oregon Superintendent of the Year Winner Officially Announced**

- The official announcement will take place during the Saturday luncheon at the OSBA Convention in Portland.
- Public announcement in the recipient’s community is expected to occur sometime between September 1 and November 10.

**2019 Superintendent of the Year**

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- 2017-18 is the first year for the OASE Education Leadership Coalition (ELC)

**Leadership resulted in three workgroups:**

- Social-Emotional Well-Being
- Early Learning
- Education Workforce Development

**Education Leadership Coalition**

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- ELC has 43 representative members:
  - OASE Presidency (3)
  - OASE Zone Directors, Executive Committee (14)
  - Regional Representatives (without Zone Director) (9)
  - ELC Representatives (based on student population) (11)
  - ELC Representatives (to assure diversity) (6)

### **ELC Membership**

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- Identify vacancies (see highlighted list)
- Notify ESD Superintendents of vacancies in their regions
- Ask regions to recommend representatives at ESD superintendent meetings in May
- OASE Executive Committee appoints ELC members on June 1
- 2018-19 ELC members notified June 4-8
