2019 Superintendent of the Year

August 11-30, 2018 - Applications Reviewed, Winner Selected

 OASE Executive Committee members will review nominations and select the 2019 Oregon Superintendent of the Year.

August 31, 2018 - Winner Notified

• The 2019 winner will be notified no later than August 31.

September 1-October 31, 2018 – Winner Receives Support for National Application

 A panel of former Oregon Superintendent of the Year Award recipients will be available to support the 2019 winner as she/he completes the national application.

November 1, 2018 - National Application Due
